A Word From the Chair

On top of Covid and the usual stress of living under military occupation, this year's olive harvest in Sabastiya was 70% down on last year, very likely due to poor weather conditions.

The pandemic has not stopped illegal Israeli settlers from vandalising olive trees and harassing families harvesting on their land. Home demolitions by the Israeli army have also increased, including the destruction of an entire community living in the Jordan Valley (See photo below). "The largest demolition for 10 years", according to the United Nation Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (UNOCHA), making 74 people homeless including 41 children. Six hundred and eighty nine structures have been demolished this year, rendering 869 Palestinians homeless (UNOCHA).



There has been a surge of Covid-19. As of December the 2nd, active cases have doubled in the Occupied Palestinian Territories and tripled in Gaza (UNOCHA). In Sabastiya at the moment there are 30 active cases. All in all, not a great situation

On a cheerier note:

Thanks to your support we have been able to purchase **300 Jaffa orange trees** for Sabastiya at a cost of £3,760. These will be planted all over Sabastiya, in farms, homes, streets and schools. The Sabastiya volunteers, which we have supported since our beginning, will be helping with the planting. We still have orange tree cards for sale should you wish to purchase one or more (see below), and any more money raised for the this project will go towards helping with the long term maintenance of the trees.


